

Hello everyone,

YEAH went through some significant updates over the past week. Please take notice of the following:

1. I strongly recommend that all users access the system via the HTML client, and discontinue using the java webstart method. This link has not changes Just open your browser, and go to <https://yehub.net/MPR.php>
2. You will notice that all pages, from the initial login forward, are now SSL-secured. Your browser will show a lock or other indicator to confirm that.
3. **The Local Connector is no longer necessary.** You'll see that the indicator for it is blue, meaning it is intentionally turned off. This increases security by maintaining the barrier between your browser and your desktop, and makes the installation process easier as well. A couple of ramifications:
 - o **Reports** that previously downloaded to your desktop and then would open in your local copy of Acrobat Reader **will now open in a browser tab**. This will be much faster and more secure for you.
 - o As for viewing documents, I cannot stress how important it is that all of you understand that browsers have settings that control how they deal with pop-ups. The act of opening a document in another browser tab is treated like a pop-up. Therefore, users need to **tell their browsers to allow pop-ups from yehub.net**. Each browser offers a different means of doing that; you just have to become familiar with the tools that you choose to use.
4. The other indicators at the bottom of the screen may be blank. Don't worry about that.
5. The screen zoom controls have been removed from the bottom left corner of the screen. You can now use your standard browser zoom controls, either through a View menu or keystroke combination (ctrl+ and ctrl- work on most Windows desktops).
