What's required of your Club if interested in hosting?

- You will need to designate a Club Member to serve as the *Youth Exchange Officer* to handle paperwork and high-level logistics.
- You will need to designate a Club Member to serve as the *Youth Exchange Counselor* to serve as the student's advocate and assist with difficulties at home/school. The *Counselor* is also responsible for finding Host Families.
